**Items commonly needed at the Food Pantry:** Breakfast cereals (hot or cold), Soups (all varieties), Canned Vegetables, Canned fruit, Pasta/spaghetti/sauces, Instant boxed potatoes, Dressings for salad, Egg noodles/Elbow Macaroni/spaghetti, Pudding/Jello, canned Beef Stew, Ketchup/Mustard, flour/Sugar (small bags), Hamburger/Tuna Helper, Peanut Butter/Jelly/Jam, Seasonings/Spices, Beans (all types), Rice, Coffee/Tea, Vegetable oil, Boxed Crackers, Canned Meats, Pancake Syrup/Syrup, Cake mix/Frosting, Macaroni & Cheese/ Stuffing/Sweet Potatoes, Canned Juices, Shampoo/Conditioner, Toothpaste/Toothbrushes, Soap, Toilet Paper, Deodorant, Paper Towels, Powdered Laundry Detergent, Dish soap, Aluminum Foil, Plastic Wrap, Ziploc Bags, Kleenex.
