+++ **SKILL OF THE WEEK** (Week 5): Asking For Help 1. Look at the person. 2. Ask the person if they have time to help you. 3. Clearly explain the kind of help that you need. 4. Thank the person for helping. If you don't understand something, it's important to ask for help. The first step in asking for help is looking at the person that you are talking to. The second step is asking the person if they have time to help you. This shows them that you are respectful of their time and what they are doing at the moment. The third step is to clearly explain the kind of help that you need. The only way that a person can really help you is if they know exactly what you need. The fourth step is to thank the person for helping you. Remember to be patient if someone can't help you right away.
