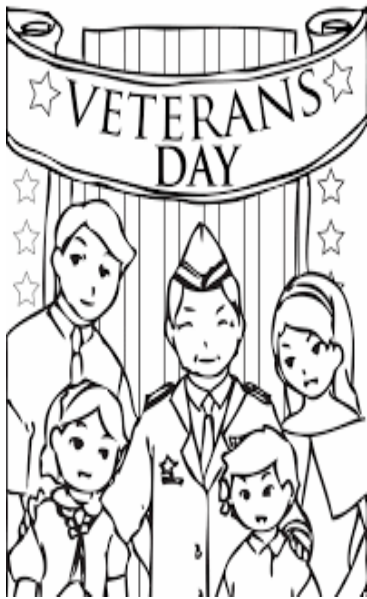

Identify the task to be completed, this helps everyone to know what you are working towards. 2. Assign tasks to each person. As a group you decide who will do what part. You may need to take turns. 3. Discuss ideas in a calm quiet voice and let everyone share their ideas. When discussing ideas stay calm and be sure to let everyone talk. Being a good listener is a big part of this step. 4. Work on tasks until completed. Stick to it! Stay on task and get the job done! You can encourage your teammates along the way.
