+++ **SKILL OF THE WEEK:** Making an Apology (Saying you're sorry): 1. Look at the person. 2. Use a serious, sincere tone. 3. Say, "I'm sorry for..." or "I want to apologize for..." 4. Explain how you plan to do better in the future. 5. Say, "Thanks for listening." Everyone makes mistakes! When you say you're sorry, other people will see that you are accepting that you made a mistake and are trying to make things better. Make sure you look directly at the person and use a tone that shows the person that you really mean what you are saying. Say the words, "I'm sorry for..." or "I apologize for..." Next explain how you will change your future behavior so that you won't have to apologize again for the same issue. Lastly you can say, "Thank you for listening to me."
