SKILL OF THE WEEK: "Accepting Criticism or a Consequence" 1. Look at the person. 2. Say, "Okay." 3. Stay calm. We all make mistakes and have to deal with negative feedback from time to time. Remember that eye contact shows respect and helps focus your attention on the person. By saying okay, you are showing you understand even if you don't agree.
